Why there are fundamental flaws at the starting point of most language learning syllabi and how to systematically break most of the "rules" of the ELT classroom.

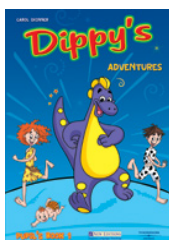

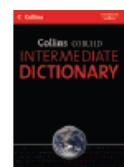
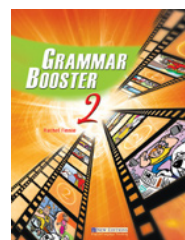
